• School Data Review

Mr. Jackman reviewed the State Report card that indicated the achievement gap had been decreased between the school proficiency average and the district average in math (2 pts), English language arts (2 pts) and science (6 pts) end of level tests. ELL students also outperformed their state counterparts by increasing their proficiency by over 60%. This was a 30% improvement from the year prior. The district average was 19% and the state average was 18%

The Student Health And Risk Prevention survey results from 2021 were also reviewed. In almost every category positive growth was made as reflected by student survey results. There was not category in which Sunset students indicated they were at elevated risks. Most categories were positively above or below state averages. This is great news on how our students are reporting on how they feel about their learning, health, and safety at Sunset Jr.

Teacher Student Success Plan 2022-2023 Discussion

After reviewing the state report card results, we discussed possible areas to focus on for next year's Teacher Student Success Plan and the use of Land Trust monies.
