School Business:

- School is working toward accreditation
- Emergency Preparedness Plan

Mr. Summers explained our school evacuation plan in case of an emergency. Designated evacuation sites include Sunset Elementary, Doxey Elementary, and the LDS church on 1600. The school is hoping to conduct an evacuation drill in the near future.



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• RAP

The new advisory "RAP" period is working well at the school. This is a daily, 35minute intervention period. Students are given 15 min to read; 20 min for homework. Students may also be "summoned" by teachers for re-teaching (not necessarily make-up work). RAP includes occasional schoolwide lessons on beneficial topics such as bullying. In addition, students in need of counseling have access to the school counselors during this time.

• Sundevil Spot

Amy Poff, faculty member, explained this opportunity happening each day during lunch. She oversees a classroom where students are invited to enjoy board games and puzzles. This has particular use with students who have a need to connect and form friendships with other students.

• Other:

Mr. Jackman gave an update on the new school being built. We are still waiting for a bond in order to proceed. It's estimated that construction will begin in Spring 2021, and will take 14-16 months to complete.
